Recommended Minimum Safety Equipment Checklist

1. Hatches must not open inwards if forward of Bmax, unless small port <0.07m²
2. Lifelines must be fitted to comply with 3.10R
3. Bilge pumps
 - a. Yachts <8.5m min 1 bilge pump
 - b. Yachts >8.5m 1 fixed pump in cockpit plus 1 other
 - c. Two buckets minimum, size 9 litre / 2 gallon + lanyard
4. Compass, permanently installed + deviation card
5. VHF Radio
6. Sail number on mainsail
7. Anchor suitable for vessel + 10m chain & 30m warp
8. First aid kit and manual
9. Charts and tide tables for areas sailed
10. Tools, spares, including wire cutters or similar
11. Yachts name on buoyant material
12. At least 1 lifebuoy readily accessible
13. Flares – minimum 2 red handed, 2 orange smoke, all in date
14. Floating heaving line
15. Lifejacket for each crew member with
 - a. Crotch strap
 - b. Whistle
 - c. Reflective tape
 - d. If auto inflate then canister must be in date
 - e. Regularly inspected as per manufactures recommendations
